By the age of 12 she had already won four first prizes as a soloist and two first prizes as a chamber musician in the German "Jugend musiziert" – a national competition for youngsters. Ms Brekalo world début was in 2011 with one of the world's best orchestras, the London Philharmonic at the Cadogan Hall in London. Her career has since taken off, with Diana having performed in the USA, Japan, China and Europe. With **Marina Solarek** (violin) and **Miriam Lowbury** (cello) the **Solarek Piano Trio** was established. Their concerts are well known for their informative and entertaining introductions. Sparkling performances combined with a friendly convivial atmosphere send audiences home elated.

Mae Heydorn is a mezzo-alto singing with Glyndebourne, Clonter, Wexford and Grange Park Opera. She performs with orchestras throughout the country and is Diana's duo partner since Music College.
